Feel the exhilaration of whitewater, hike through ancient canyons, play in waterfalls, give back to your community, learn about your environment, make new friends, move beyond your comfort zone, and work as part of a team. A river trip can be a truly transformational experience, especially for youth. Join us!

A Quality Program at an Affordable Price

GCY has been providing experiential river education programs for over 10 years. As a nonprofit organization we work hard to raise funds to keep the price of our programs as affordable as possible. In fact, GCY covers over 70% of the cost! The price of your river program includes: detailed pre-trip support, professional guides, transportation to and from the river, meals, river equipment, sleeping supplies and waterproof bags. Financial aid is available.

Through our program, youth participate fully in every aspect of their experience, from paddling boats to setting up camp to presenting educational projects.

How it Works

Participating in a GCY program is more than showing up at the river. The places we take you are so special we believe you should earn your spot on the trip, by committing in three ways:

- Community service: Get involved, step outside your comfort zone, learn more about your community and help others!
- Prepare an educational project: Get curious about where you will be traveling and choose a topic of interest by preparing a 10-minute interactive presentation to share with your peers while on the river.
- Earn a portion of the trip cost: This ensures that you are responsible and invested in getting the most out of your river program.

More information about pre-trip requirements will be sent to you with the application packet.


Custom Group Programs

This 11-day program includes spending a few days at the South Rim involved in service projects, getting to know your peers and working as a team, before embarking on an exciting river trip. Once on the river, the hands-on activities continue as



you assist in research projects with Grand Canyon scientists, hike gorgeous side canyons and ride the famous whitewater of the Colorado River. This trip is in collaboration with Grand Canyon National Park. *Ages 15-19*

MIDDLE SCHOOL ADVENTURE

Jump feet first into the San Juan River in Southeastern Utah to explore the interactions between fish, bugs, plants and other river life. As part of this 6-day program, youth have the opportunity to work alongside scientists to collect data related to this amazing river. Learn about how invasive species have changed the ecology of the river and

the ongoing efforts to restore it. If you've ever wondered how fish see in muddy water, come learn the answer to this and many other intriguing questions. This is a great introductory river experience for middle school students. *Ages 11-14*

NATIVE AMERICAN YOUTH ARTISTS PROGRAM



This innovative 4-day program is for Native American youth interested in developing their artistic skills against the stunning backdrop of the San Juan River. Participants keep their kits so they can continue their artistic journey at home. At the end of the trip each participant donates a piece
