Voices of the Next Generation SF is an urgent grassroots campaign calling on City Leaders to Invest Now in Opportunities for the Next Generation!


1) HONOR THE CITY'S INVESTMENTS IN SF'S NEXT GENERATION:

2) 通過公平計劃, 為所有中學畢業生上大學院校及能夠維持生計的工作作好準備。


- 為支持和增加他們成功的機會, 期望培養不同族裔的學生。

STOP BUDGET CUTS & RACIAL TRACKING IN OUR SCHOOLS!

Invest in opportunities for the next generation! ¡Inviertan en Oportunidades para la Próxima Generación!

⇒ In the next couple of months, city leaders plan to cut millions in city services, including investments in children and youth that we've won over the last generation.



⇒ And, the city's special safety-net Funds for kids are under attack. SF voters created The Children's Fund & the Fund for Public Education Enrichment years ago, and now more than 50,000 children and young people could lose the affordable childcare, afterschool programs, youth jobs, services for immigrant families, and violence prevention services that are helping to keep us safe.

Our future depends on whether city leaders invest in us! No budget cuts to the youth!

⇒ The economic crisis has hit our families hard – budget cuts will make our situation worse. Unemployment in San Francisco has more than doubled in just the last two years – 40,000 people are out of work! Before the crisis, 43% of SF families were low-income – now that number is rising, and even more families will be depending on the city's safety net services.


It's not fair I'm not being prepared for college. I believe in my future, do you?

⇒ Young people need good jobs, but it's not like the old days. Their future in the 21st century San Francisco economy now requires a college education. More than 50,000 blue-collar jobs that paid a living wage without a degree have disappeared from SF over the last generation.


⇒ All students have the right to a quality education, and a student's race shouldn't determine their future. But data show that most Black, Latino and Pacific Islander students are being denied equal educational opportunities, and are 'tracked' or segregated into the classes with low academic expectations. They get the least opportunities to develop the high-level skills and the critical thinking required in the 21st century economy.

⇒ Only 1 in 3 students from SF schools graduated from high school prepared for a four-year university in 2008. Without access to college and career-ready "A thru G" classes, most graduating students weren't even *eligible* for UC or CSU universities or prepared for a union apprenticeship exam.

⇒ Most Black, Latino and Pacific Islander students do not have access the "A thru G" college and career path in San Francisco: 5 out of 6 Latino students, and 9 out of 10 African American students graduated without the A-G classes required to even be eligible for a UC or CSU university. Instead, students of color are being tracked into poverty wage jobs or work in the street economy that can send them straight to prison. Many go to community college – but the truth is that few ever transfer to 4 yr colleges. In order to address the poverty and violence in our communities, students of color must be prepared for college & living wage work.




ALTO A LOS CORTES PRESUPUESTALES & ALTO AL SEGUIMIENTO DETERMINADO POR RAZA



- Los líderes de la ciudad planean recortar millones de dólares en servicios de la ciudad para niños.
- Los Fondos especiales de la ciudad para niños están bajo ataque.
- La crisis económica ha golpeado duro a nuestras familias.
- Todos los estudiantes tienen el derecho a una educación de calidad y la raza del estudiante no debe determinar su futuro.
- El futuro de los jóvenes en la economía de S.F. en el siglo 21 ahora requiere una licenciatura.
- Solamente 1 de 3 estudiantes de las escuelas de S.F. se graduaron de la preparatoria preparados para la universidad en el 2008.
- La mayoría de los estudiantes Afroamericanos, Latinos y de las Islas del Pacífico no tienen acceso al camino de las clases de la “A hasta la G” para el colegio o una carrera en San Francisco.

- 修補城市預算的危機, 城市領袖正在計劃削減成千上萬的城市服務.
- 城市資助孩子的特別安全網受到攻擊.
- 但是經濟危機擊中了我們艱苦辛勤的家庭.
- 21世紀的三藩市經濟, 現在要求青年人未來需要擁有大學院校教育程度.
- 但是在2008年, 每三名高中畢業的學生中僅得一名學生能從三藩市學校作好準備進入四年的大學院校.
- 多數的美國非州裔、拉丁美洲裔和太平洋島裔學生在三藩市未能通過「A至G」而進入大學院校和職業：
- 所有學生有權利得到高質素的教育, 並且學生的種族不應該確定他們的未來.


